

Spanish Dehydrated Forages

Other dehydrated forages produced in Spain

In addition to alfalfa, Spain produces other forages, such as **Festuca**, **Raygrass**, **Forage Oats**, and **Silage Corn**. These plant varieties are dehydrated to make products that are highly recommended as part of a **healthy and safe diet for livestock in both meat and dairy production**.



Dehydrated Raygrass

It has a high caloric content. It can be used as a supplement feed in diets requiring a high caloric intake. It can be used to feed dairy cows and is also recommended for the diets of sheep, horses, and even calves.



Dehydrated Forage Oats

It can be used alone or in combination with other fodder legumes (alfalfa). It is considered to be an excellent feed due to its high level of digestible fibre, low level of potassium, and pleasant flavour. This product is a wonderful forage, particularly for horses, cattle, and sheep.



Dehydrated Festuca

It is a herbaceous plant with a high content of digestible fibre and great caloric value.

It is a very nutritious forage for herbivores. It is highly valued for its digestibility and is especially suitable for horses, cattle, and sheep.



Dehydrated Silage Corn

It has a high caloric value, is very high in fibre, and contains high levels of vitamins and minerals. Mixed with alfalfa, it provides a complete and nutritious feed for livestock.
